

# Copyright Office Licensing Division Service Fees

The Licensing Division in the Copyright Office administers the compulsory and statutory licenses in the Copyright Act (title 17 of the *United States Code*). Copyright Office Licensing Division service fees are subject to change. For current fees, check the Copyright Office website at [www.copyright.gov](http://www.copyright.gov), write the Licensing Division, or call (202) 707-8150.

## Licensing Service Fees, effective August 1, 2009

- \$100 Statement of account amendment (cable television systems, satellite carriers and digital audio recording devices or media, 17 *USC* 111, 119, and 1003)
- \$60 Recordation of a notice of intention to make and distribute phonorecords (17 *USC* 115) for first title. \$20 for additional titles (per group of 10)
- \$140 Filing fee for recordation of license agreement for the use of certain works in connection with noncommercial broadcasting under 17 *USC* 118
- \$50 Recordation of certain contracts by cable television systems located outside the 48 contiguous states
- \$25 Notice of use of sound recordings under statutory license (17 *USC* 112 and 114)
- \$25 Amendment of 17 *USC* 112 and 114 notice
- \$0.50 Photocopy made by staff (B&W) (per page, minimum \$12)
- \$165 Search report, per hour
- \$165 Certification of search report
